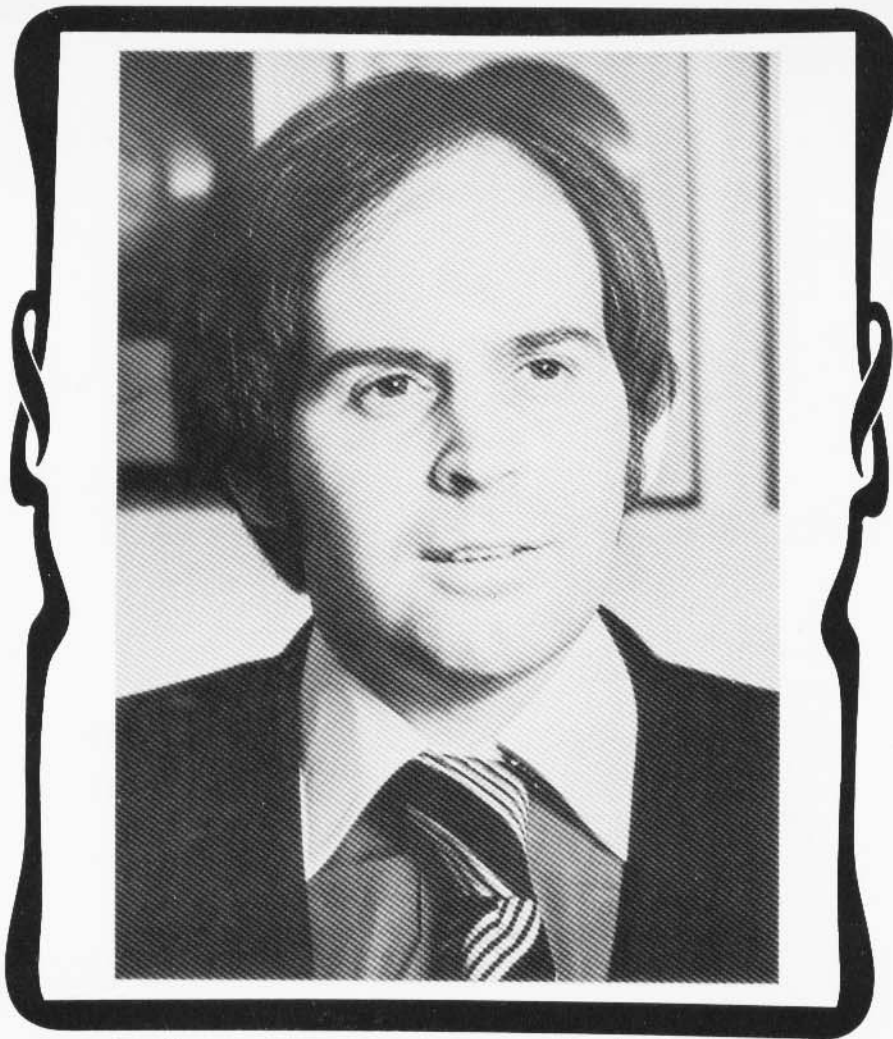

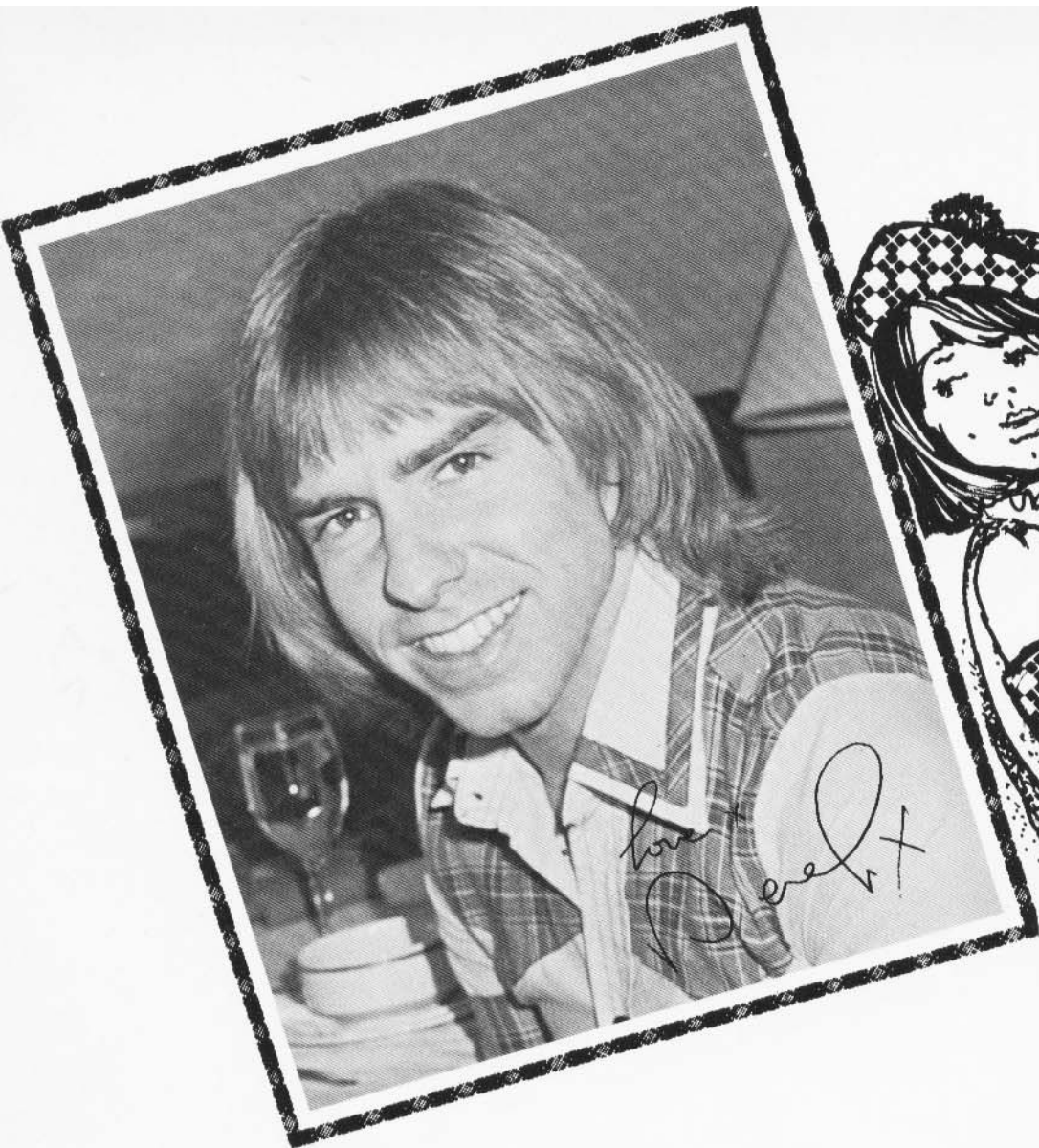

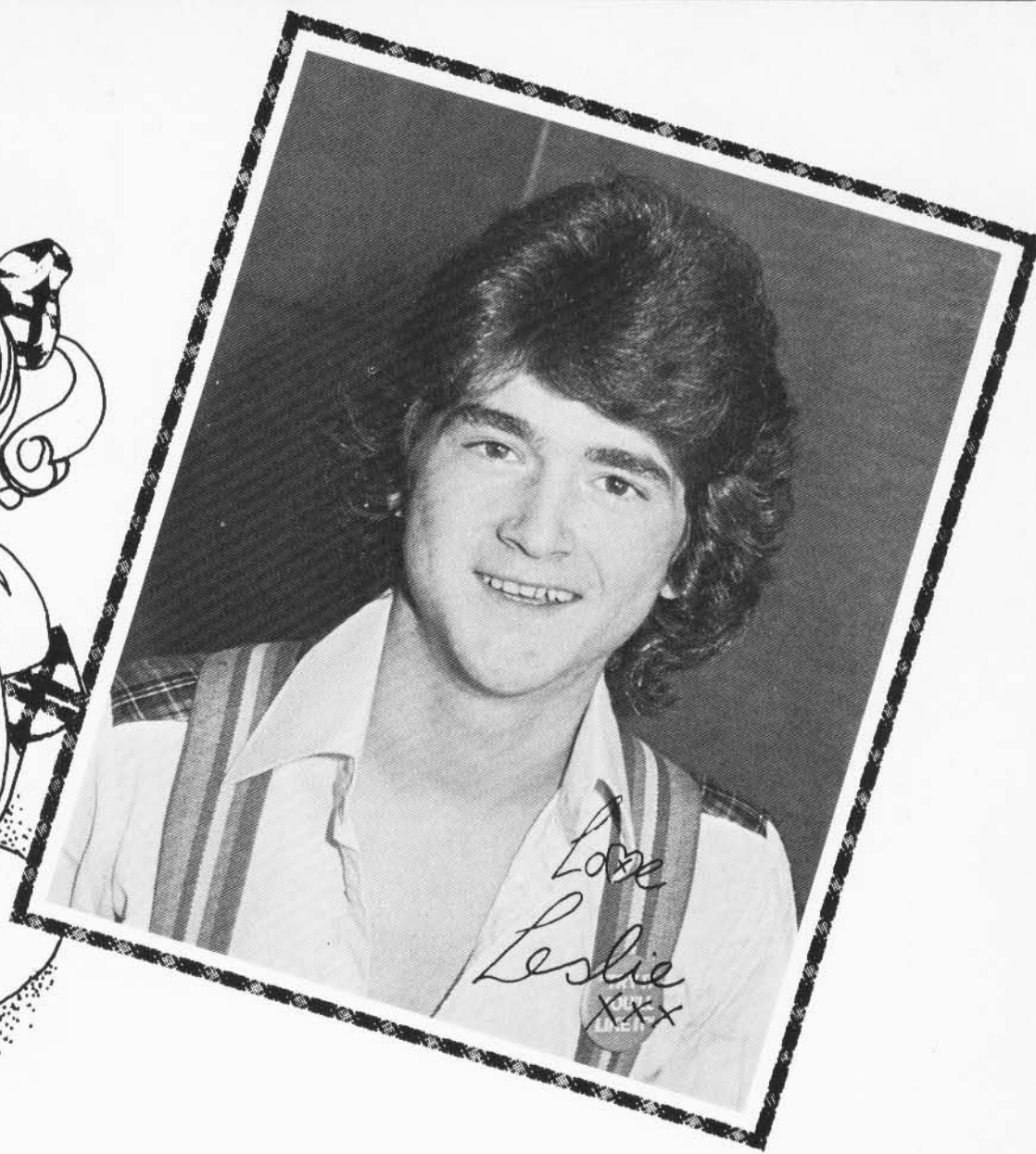

A SHORTY JACKET - trimmed up with Tartan for a nifty look... denim would work super or else any colour blending with the trim.

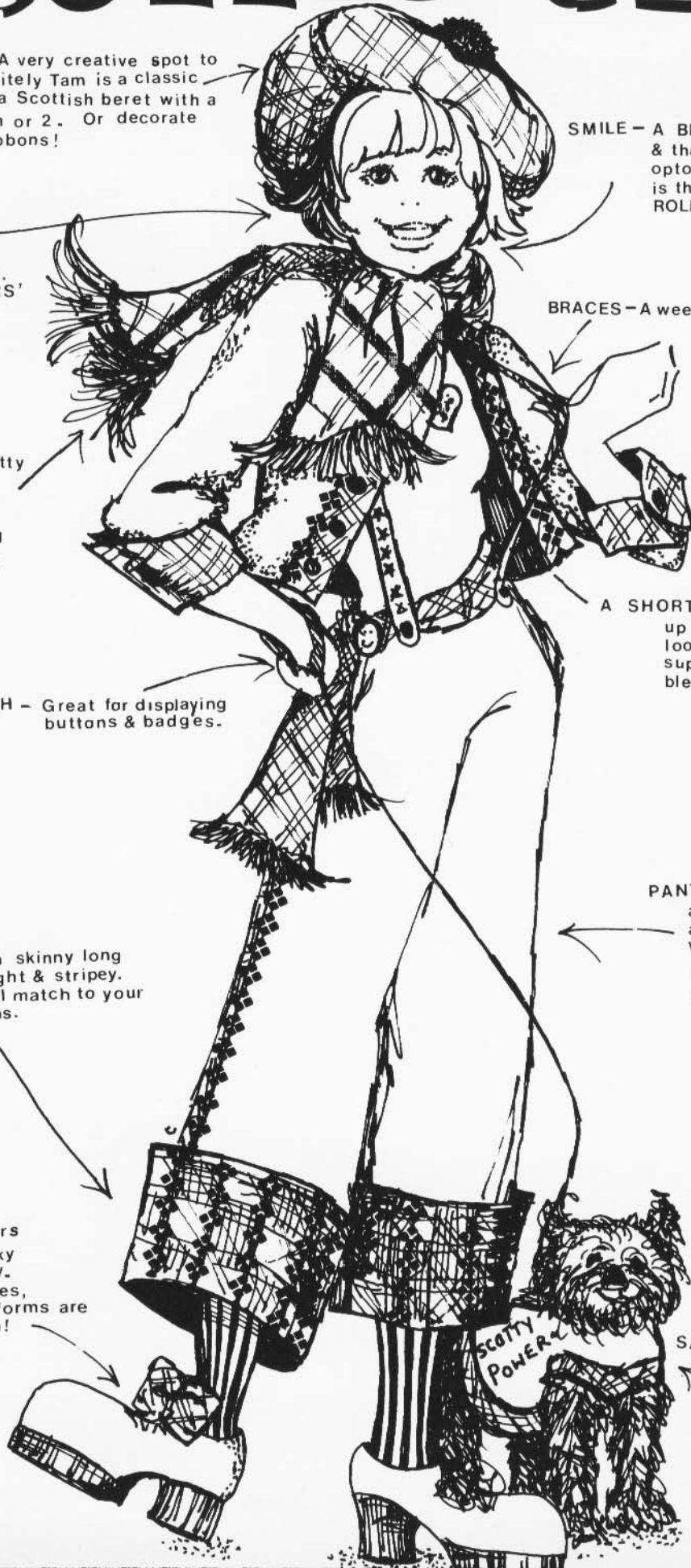
A WAIST SASH - Great for displaying buttons & badges.

THE STORY

ONCE UPON A TIME IN THE LAND OF EDINBURGH, two Scottish musicians created a Rock & Roll group called the Saxons. Their career was riddled with struggle & hardship in their efforts to become KNOWN. How much EASIER the struggle might have been to handle had they foreseen their destiny of INTERNATIONAL STARDOM! Could they EVER have believed 8 years ago, when disappointment & meager funds sought to crumble their will to succeed, that now... they'd be the most dynamic band in the land! In part, perhaps they did sense it, for some inner strength had to be - to keep the rollers rollin' til their time would come. Someone alongside them also felt for their future - TAM PATON. The Rollers' manager. Through constant faith in their abilities, he sustained them through thick & thin. Only JEREK remains from the original rollers. Eric, Les & Woody were the next to join. JAN officially became a roller in April, '76 when ALAN bowed out for a less hectic, whirlwind life. Complete now is their 5 member band of solid, polished musicians. & the response to them has been purely phenomenal! In '76 against all odds, this unknown group jetted to America's top 20 with "Saturday Night". A few weeks later "Money Money" hit high on the U.S. scene. And success has been sustained via their constant output of excellent material.

So much has occurred in static spots to the rollers! Periods of creative frustration blended with bits of fame... to now having a near golden touch with singles. In the early tough days, all the while TAM was busy

guarding & guiding the Rollers, luck struck suddenly when Dick Leahy of Bell Records chanced to catch their act. He saw, he heard, he signed them. Shortly thereafter, the Rollers had their first hit: "KEEP ON DANCING". "Saturday Night" was next released — & failed in Britain. All seemed hopeless again — not for long! "REMEMBER" was soon released — & it flew to #6. Earning a Silver Disc! "Shang-a-lang" followed & hit #3 resulting in their 20 week TV series in Britain. The Rollers' second four came with a #2 winner: "SUMMER LOVE SENSATION". Their next two singles — "All of me loves All of you" & "Bye Bye Baby" both earned Silver Discs — the latter ultimately a gold disc. Their next single "Give a little love" shot to #1 trailed close by "Money money".

Clearly it is the time of the Rollers. & they've earned it! The Rollers third album "Wouldn't you like it" contained 11 out of 12 tracks by the Rollers' Faulkner/Wood team! Next came Howard Cosset's show in New York. Then sell-outs in Australia. Awards & recognition flooding in faster & faster & popularity with their fans spreading throughout the lands. Their secret dreams of success have become a reality with the world. Earlier sceptics & critics have come to praise their story.

If there was a moral to this real-life Scottish fairy tale it would have to be thus: Be the best you you can be, Be yourself! Believe in yourself! & Go after your dreams! The Rollers did just that. & in doing so, they're making the world a cheerier, more melodic place to be.

And for their music fans' sake as well as for the Bay City Rollers... we wish them well —
& that they live happily ever after.

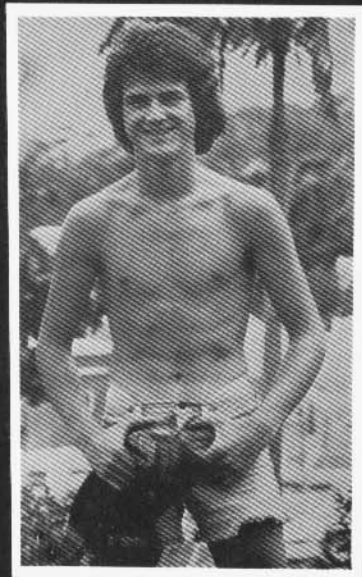

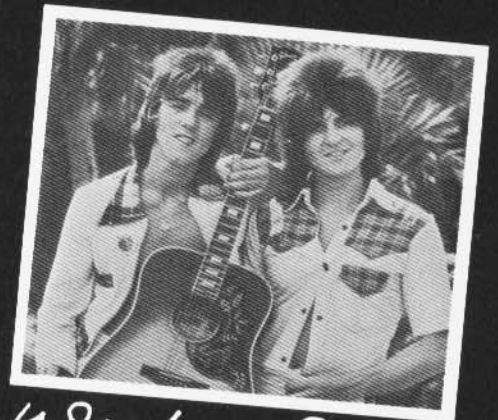

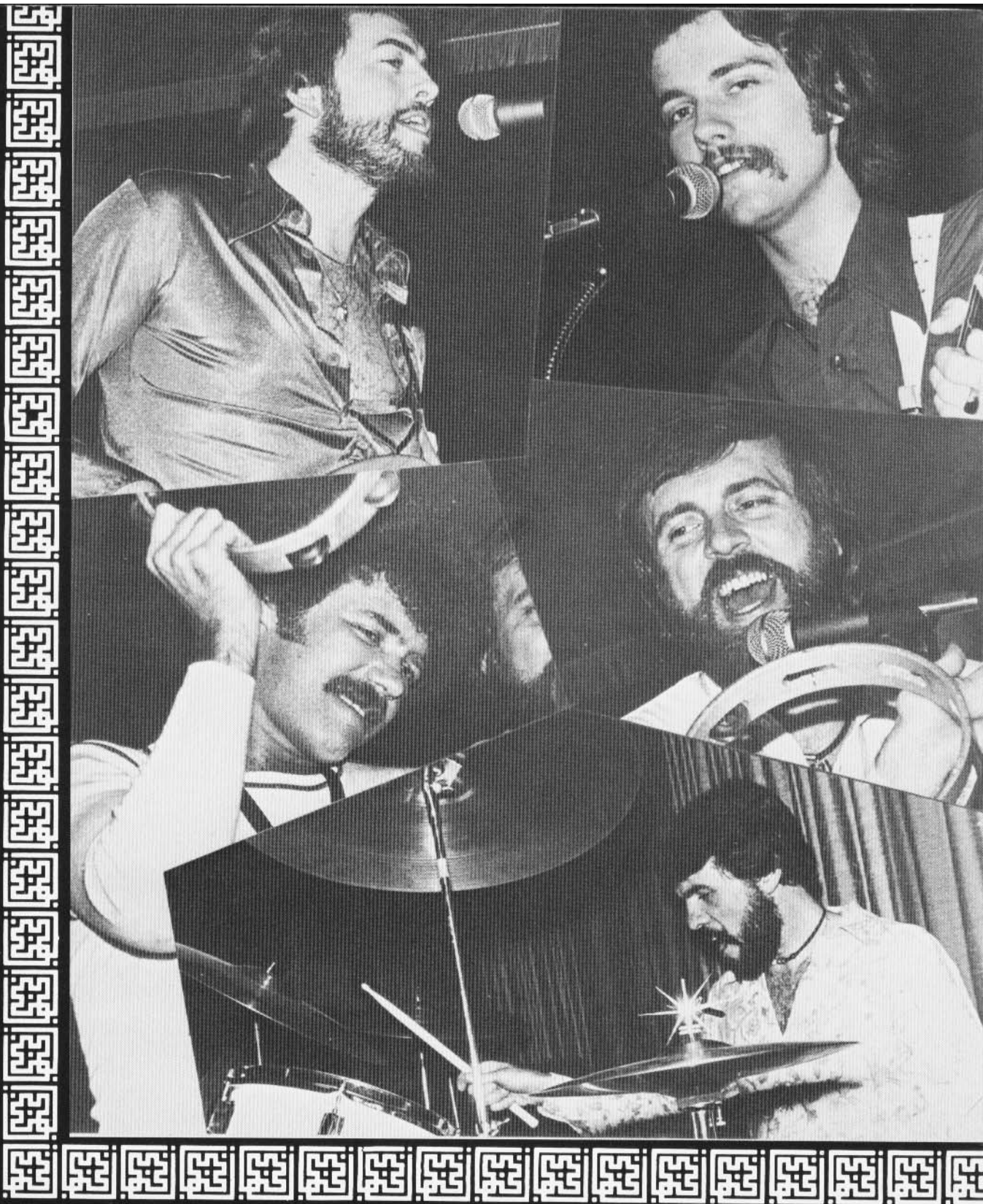
